

Notice to Exhibitors:

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under 6 months are strictly prohibited from the grounds, and will be excused from the crating area.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Express Mail and delivery service entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient's signature. Call or e-mail Trial Secretary for delivery information.

Errors on entry forms: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded or entries cancelled in event of such errors after the published closing date. Please TYPE or PRINT CAREFULLY the information on the entry form to minimize errors.

Faxed, telegraphed, telephoned, e-mailed, unsigned entries, or entries not on official AKC Agility entry form (or photocopy) with Agreement and instructions attached cannot be accepted.

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with identification numbers and a Judging program. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Injured dogs and bitches in season: The Club will refund all but \$9 of the entry fee upon presentation of a note from a veterinarian stating that the bitch is in season or the dog is unable to compete due to injury. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund prior to the start of classes or by letter postmarked prior to September 30, 2009.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Treasurer will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Dogs in the Preferred class **MUST** run in their proper height class.

A photocopy of your AKC Permanent Jump Height Card must be attached to the entry form or presented the day of the trial. Any dog without a valid Jump Height Card or any dog that has not been officially measured for a Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured **prior** to running at each trial.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of "Regulations for Agility Trials" from the American Kennel Club.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk through period will be held prior to each class.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Entry Information

Entries cannot be accepted earlier than 7AM, Monday, July 27, 2009.

In the event a delivery, in which a numerical limit has been reached, contains entries in excess of that limit, entries will be selected from that delivery by random draw. A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. After September 23, 2009 entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or altered, except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. All the rules and regulations as they appear in the latest "Regulations for Agility Trials" shall apply.

Show Site Information

FOOD (see attached form) and indoor restrooms are available on site.

Dogs may be exercised on show site only. Keep our neighbors happy. Dogs are not permitted in the Fossil Park. Please clean up after your dog. Small plastic bags are provided at the trial site for dog waste pickup. Waste containers are available in designated potty areas. Do not deposit dog waste in building.

There is no overnight parking for campers and motor homes at show site. Camping sites with restrooms are available at Winton Woods County Park (513-851-2267), approximately 5 miles from site.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
